Information to the Parents of Nursery

- 1. New academic session will begin on Monday, 18th April 2022 for class Nursery
- 2. School timing for Nursery students on all days is **8:30am 12:15pm**. Parents need to be on time during the arrival and departure to drop and take your ward.
- 3. Bus facility is available for all directions, kindly fix the bus point at the school reception desk.
- 4. Parents need to submit the following on **Tuesday**, 12th **April 2022** to the class teacher: Books, Copies, and a set of civil dress with undergarments, medium size towel and a hand wash ensure that your ward's name is written on the carry bag and on all the other materials.
- 5. Parents of Nursery students need not send pencil boxes, pencils and eraser throughout the year as it will be provided in the school.
- 6. Girls need to wear white cloth hair band compulsorily; girls having long hair should braid their hair in two with white ribbon. No fancy clips or any other hair accessories are allowed.
- 7. Boys are not permitted to have any fancy hair styles. Hair should be trimmed short. It is recommended that the hair should be either, crew cut, buzz cut or close cut.
- 8. Kindly read through the guidelines mentioned in the school diary.
- 9. Books, notebooks will be kept in the school and minimum home assignments will be given in order to ensure minimum bag weight.
- 10. Please write only the name and class of the child on the books and the notebooks with a permanent black marker before covering it with a transparent cover.
- 11. Please check the school diary everyday as it is the means to communicate with you and ensure the completion of home assignments and sign on the diary daily.
- 12. Please respond through the school diary only, parents are not allowed to write any comments on copies or books.

- 13. Child should be toilet trained.
- 14. Nails should be clean and pared.
- 15. Child can be brought in civil dress for first week in school if uniform is not ready.
- 16. Shoes should be purchased from outside.
- 17. Uniform and Civil dress
 - Monday and Friday- Shirt with Tie and Pant/Skirt along with black school shoes and school socks.
 - Tuesday and Thursday- T-Shirt and Pant/Skirt along with white canvas shoes and school socks.
 - Wednesday- Civil Dress, Civil Shoes.
 - All girl students should wear black shorts (tights) under skirt on all days.
 - ID Card is a must every day. Once an ID card is made it shouldn't be damaged/broken as it will not be issued again.
 - School will also issue a bus card which will be tagged on the school bag of the students. Kindly ensure the bag tag remains at all times on the bag.
- 18. Kindly make phone calls on school phone no. **0353-2699111** and **9679293719** (For calls and WhatsApp) during school working hours: 8.30am 4.00pm. In case of any emergencies, call the on **9476129611**.
- 19. Please enter absent remark in leave attendance page in diary.
- 20. In case a student wants leave for more than two days, kindly submit a written application letter to Principal through the Class teacher.
- 21. In case of sick leave, kindly attach medical certificate issued by the doctor.
- 22. For **Birthday Celebration**: cake, colored clothes, soft drinks and distribution of stationeries are not allowed. Only distribution of toffees or chocolates is allowed.
- 23. Parents kindly ensure that vaccination of your child is done as per the age of the child.
- 24. Parents are not allowed to discuss the academic progress of the child at bus stops or at dispersal with teachers.
- 25. In order to meet Class teacher, prior appointment must be taken at the reception.
- 26. Meeting hours to meet Principal is from 11.00am 12.00pm from Monday to Saturday, with prior appointment.
- 27. Child must wear mask, carry a bottle of 100ml sanitizer and be taught Covid Protocols.
